No. -----.- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 read with sub-section (1) of section 23 of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 (Mah. XXVIII of 2015), the Government of Maharashtra hereby makes the following rules, regulating submission of Annual Report of the Admissions Regulating Authority, as follows:-

1. Short title and commencement -

(1) These rules may be called the Maharashtra Admissions Regulating Authority (Annual Report) Rules, 2025.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Maharashtra Government Gazette.

2. Definitions-

(1) In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,-

(a) “Act” means the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 (Mah. XXVIII of 2015);

(b) “Accounts” means the Accounts of the Authority and the State CET-Cell.

(c) “Annual Report” means the Annual Report of the activities of the Authority and the State Common Entrance Test Cell in respect of the previous financial year;

(d) “Audit by the Chartered Accountant” means the audit of the Authority and State Common Entrance Test Cell by the Chartered Accountant registered with the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

(e) “Authority” means the Admissions Regulating Authority;

(f) “Chairperson” means the Chairperson of the Authority;

(g) “Examiners” includes the Chief Moderators, evaluators, item-writers, moderators, paper-setters, reviewers, and scrutinisers by whatever designation called, appointed by the Competent Authority for the conduct of the CET and also includes the persons appointed under sub-section (6) of section 10 of the Act;

(h) “Form” means the form appended to these rules;

(i) “Member Secretary” means the Member Secretary of the Authority.

(j) “Year” means the period of twelve months commencing on the 1st April and ending on the ensuing 31st March.

(2) Words and expressions used but not defined herein shall have the respective meaning as assigned to them in the Act.

3. Annual Report of the Authority -

(1) Every Year the Member Secretary shall, within seven months of the end of the year, get its Accounts audited through a Chartered Accountant (registered with the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.)

(2) The Authority shall appoint such Chartered Accountant and the terms and conditions of his appointment shall be such as may be specified by the Authority.

(3) After the report of the Chartered Accountant under sub-rule (1) is received by the Member Secretary, the same may be placed, within one month, before the Authority and the Authority shall take such remedial measures on the observations and report of the Chartered Accountant, as it may deem fit.

(4) After such report has been considered under sub-rule (3), the Authority shall cause to be prepared, the Annual Report of its activities within one month.

(5) The Annual Report shall be in the Form “A”.

4. Submission of the Report -

(1) Every report prepared under Rule 3 shall be submitted to the State Government as early as possible and preferably before the 31st January of the next year.

(2) If the report of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, under section 18 is received subsequently, a copy thereof shall be forwarded to the State Government separately.

(3) The Authority shall also forward the necessary number of copies of Annual Report for being laid on the table of both Houses of the State Legislature.
