Act No. XXVIII of 2015) which came into force on 12th May, 2015, the Pravesh Niyantran Samiti existing as on the date of commencement of the Act shall continue to exercise the powers of the Admissions Regulating Authority till such Authority is duly constituted under the Act.

Minutes of the Meeting of the Admissions Regulating Authority held on Thursday, 16th November, 2017 in the Conference Hall, Office of the Directorate of AYUSH Department, Mumbai - 400 001 are approved and confirmed, subject to following modifications/corrections.

A) Item No. 13 should be read as under :-

"Item No. 13: To consider, discuss and decide on the pending proposals of approval of admissions in 15% NRI Quota for Health Science Courses.

The Authority perused the report submitted by the Office w.r.t. some of the pending proposals of approval of admissions in 15% NRI Quota for Health Science Courses. The Authority noted the same.

After deliberations, the Authority expressed its displeasure with the concerned Colleges/Institutes, for not submitting requisite documents, complete in all respect to the office of the Authority and cautioned to reject claim for approval of admissions of above candidates in 15% NRI Quota, for the respective Academic Year, if the documents are not submitted within three weeks from the date of communication by the Authority office to the concerned College/Institute. The concerned College/Institute shall inform respective students immediately and submit the requisite documents, complete in all respect immediately to the office of the Authority. The Authority further decides that if the concerned Student/College/Institute fails to submit the requisite documents within three weeks, then such admission may be considered as cancelled. The Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority may reasonably do the scrutiny/verification and finally take appropriate decision as directed already by the Authority in its meeting held on 01-03-2017, at item no. 8(b) and in meeting dated 04-05-2017 at Item No. 1. (as per the minutes of meeting of the Authority dated 12-7-2017, Item no.14 (a) (ii)) Office to inform accordingly to the College and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

- As shown in column no. 4 and 7, out of total 3510 Higher and Technical Educational Institutes, 1256 institutes of Higher and Technical Courses and out of total 431 Institutes, 132 institutes of Health Science courses have not so far submitted their admissions details online.
- As shown in column no. 8, out of Total no. of Institutes only 1104 Institutes of Higher and Technical Education department have submitted their proposals for approval of admissions duly certified by concerned directorates in office of the



Admissions Regulating Authority. Institutes of Medical Education have not yet submitted the proposals for approval of admissions.

iii) It is also noticed that the verification of admissions of respective colleges from concerned directorates have not been completed, as expected.

After deliberations, the Authority decides as follows:-

- 1. To extend and to allow the Colleges/Institutes to submit their admission details online upto 31st December 2017 for the Academic Year 2017-18, subject to payment of penalty @20% per month on total 'Processing Fees', as approved by the Authority earlier.
- 2. To permit the Colleges/Institutes to submit the proposals for approval of admissions upto 31st December 2017 duly certified by concerned directorates in prescribed formats.
- 3. In continuation to this the Authority decides that the Colleges/Institutes who failed to submit such admissions details online and proposals for approval of admissions within prescribed time limit may not be considered for approval of the Authority and admissions of such Colleges/Institutes shall deemed to be rejected, without further intimation, which may be noted by the College/Institute and the concerned Students/Parents.

The Authority further directs the office to inform the above decision of the Authority to all concerned Directorates, Universities, Colleges/Institutes. The concerned Colleges/Institutes will inform the decision to the students/parents. Office to take necessary steps.

Item No. 4: To discuss and decide w.r.t accommodation in Mumbai for the Members of the ARA and Special Invitee officers appointed for various work related to the Authority.

The Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority invited kind attention of the Authority on the note submitted on the subject and sought directions of the Authority on it.

After deliberations the Authority directs to write letter to the Government of Maharashtra for urgent accommodations, if any available. The Authority further decides to authorize the Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority to find out suitable place for accommodation for the Members/Officers, those who assist and come to Mumbai from remote places to work for the Authority and be placed before the Authority for its consideration.

Item No. 5: Seeking permission for submitting Audit files of Admission Regulating Authority's office to the concerned Chartered Accountant.

The Office of the Authority submitted the Account statement for the period upto November 2017 for perusal of the Authority, which is marked as $\bf Annexure - A$.

The Authority perused the statement and decides to accede to the request made by the Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority and directs to take necessary steps w.r.t. audit files of the Authority from concerned Chartered Accountant.

The Authority further directs the aforesaid Colleges/Institutes to submit their say within two weeks to the Authority. Item No. 9:

To consider and decide on the letter dated 21st November 2017 received from Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai regarding admissions in remaining vacancy of Schedule Tribe (ST) category in the Academic Year 2017-18, along with Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 06-09-2017 in Civil Appeal Nos. 11234-48 of 2017 and representation dated 24/11/2017 submitted by Tribal Doctors Forum Maharashtra.

Dr. A.S. Vyas, Exam Co-Ordinator, State CET-CELL stated as follows,-

- 1. Cut off date for admission of MBBS Course is fixed by Order of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition no. 76/2015.
- 2. The admissions in respect of ST Category in MBBS and BDS Course for Academic Year 2017-18 is prescribed by Hon'ble High Court, Mumbai and Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of Writ Petition no. 10305/2017,10306/2017 and 10307/2017 dated 06/10/2017.
- 3. As stated in Supreme Court Order "The admission shall take place within a week after the Judgment is pronounce by the High Court and such admission has been conducted and completed within period."
- 4. The admission process for ST Category candidates has been conducted by State CET CELL from 12th October 2017 to 18th October 2017, as per the Order of Hon'ble High Court, Mumbai dated 06-10-2017.

The Authority, after deliberations, concludes that as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 18-08-2017 SLP-(C) 20210/2017 last date for admissions to M.B.B.S. course for the Academic Year 2017-18 was over. Hence Authority decides that no action is necessary at this stage from the Authority and the Court Order is to be obeyed.

Item No. 10:

To consider and decide on the letter dated 24th November 2017 received from Director, AYUSH submitting the report of observers in respect of the admission done in Smt. Vimaladevi College of Ayurved, Chandrapur. (Ref: Minutes of Meeting dated 4/05/2017)

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority decide to accept the observations dated 24-11-2017 submitted by the Directorate of AYUSH, Mumbai along with remarks/comments submitted by the Observer appointed by the Directorate of

The Authority perused the email dated 05-09-2017, 04-10-2017, 05-10-2017, 06-10-2017, 16-10-2017, 18-10-2017, 22-11-2017 and 08-12-2017 received from Ku. Durgaprasad H. Gupta. of Aditya Dental College, Beed. It is noticed that Ku. Durgaprasad Gupta vide its email dated 08-12-2017 has intimated to commit suicide, due to non-approval of his admission in First Year BDS course under 15% NRI Quota admitted in Academic Year 2012-13. Accordingly, the Authority decides to call the aforesaid College/Institute as well as all students/parents along with their all requisite documents before the Authority meeting w.r.t. the admission done in 15% NRI Quota for the Academic Year 2012-13.

It is noticed that aforesaid College/Institute as well as the students/parents did not submit their requisite documents to the Authority, substantiating claims of admissions in 15% NRI Quota even after reminders. The Authority rejected the claim of approval of the admissions on the students of Aditya Dental College, Beed in 15% NRI Quota for the Academic Year 2012-13 in its meeting dated 15/09/2015 and 1/03/2017.



In this connection the Authority heard Dr. Khiyani, Principal, Aditya Dental College, Beed on behalf of the College/Institute and Ku. Durgaprasad H. Gupta, Ku. Prem Y. Kaskar, Ku. Priyanka D. Paneria, Ku. Ruchira Ugale (along with their parents) students admitted in 15% NRI Quota for the Academic Year 2012-13.

In view of the above, the Authority decides to give last opportunity to these students keeping in mind the academic welfare of students. The Authority directs the students to submit the undertaking in respect of submission of all relevant documents to prove the relationship between sponsor and candidate and also to prove the NRI status of sponsor within 15 days. The Authority Further made it clear that the requisite documents complete in all respect should be submitted by the candidate/parents/college/institute to the Authority office for approval, within two weeks, from the date of the meeting/ hearing. - a) Due to various problems faced by the CET CELL during conduction of the above mentioned CET's pertaining to Higher Education, the Officer on Special Duty (OSD) and Examination Co-ordinator, Higher Education submitted a proposal to initiate the action against the US Technology International Pvt. Ltd.
