Act No. XXVIII of 2015) which came into force on 12th May, 2015, the Pravesh Niyantran Samiti existing as on the date of commencement of the Act shall continue to exercise the powers of the Admissions Regulating Authority till such Authority is duly constituted under the Act.

Chief Secretary, Higher and Technical Education Dept., Mantralaya, Mumbai).

After deliberations the Authority decides and directed as under,-

- 1. No admissions will be given on the basis of undertaking.
- 2. As referred above at sr. no. 4 The opinion given by Law and Judiciary Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai cannot be acted upon by the Authority, because the orders from the Hon'ble Supreme Court and High Court are into existence.
- 3. In case the student doesn't have Caste Validity Certificate, their application can be considered on the basis of i) Caste Certificate and ii) proof/acknowledgment of submission of proposal for Caste Validity Certificate to concerned Authority, subject to production of copy of Caste Validity Certificate before the date of First Selection Round/date given to submit such certificate in the schedule.
- 4. The concerned Director's (Nodal Officers) are instructed to re-schedule the dates of admission process within a limits of respective Court orders / Council norms to submit the Caste Validity Certificate and get the schedule confirmed by this Authority. They are also informed to give vide publicity for revised schedule at their level and respective department.
- 5. In any case, the candidate failed to submit Caste Validity Certificate on or before the date given to him, such candidate will be considered under General Category, if otherwise eligible.
