Act No. XXVIII of 2015) which came into force on 12<sup>th</sup> May, 2015, **the Pravesh Niyantran Samiti existing as on the date of commencement of the Act shall continue to exercise the powers of the Admissions Regulating Authority till such Authority is duly constituted under the Act.**

- i) As shown in column no. 5, out of total expected 3519 Institutes/Colleges of Higher and Technical Education, 962 institutes and out of total expected 379 Institutes/Colleges of Health Science courses, 54 Institutes/Colleges have not submitted their admissions details online.
- ii) As shown in column no. 6, out of total expected 3519 Institutes/Colleges of Higher and Technical Education 2073 Institutes/Colleges and out of total 379 Institutes/Colleges of Medical Education 241 Institutes have submitted their proposals in the office of Admissions Regulating Authority for approval of admissions duly certified by concerned Directorates.
- iii) As shown in column 8 of table 'A', the total no. of 883 proposals of Higher and Technical Education and of table 'B' the total no. of 75 proposals of Medical Education were scrutinized and put for approval of admissions before Authority, the details of these proposals are given in Item No. 13 & 22(2), respectively.

- iv) As shown in column no. 11 of table 'A' total no. of 330 and column No. 11 of table 'B' total no. of 69 proposals for approval of admissions are under scrutiny of office.
- v) As shown in column no. 12 of table 'A' total no. of 1446 and column No. 12 of table 'B' total no. of 138 proposals are yet to be submitted by the Colleges/Institutes for approval of admission.

It is noticed that the verification process of admissions of all respective colleges from concerned directorates has not been completed, within the stipulated period as per the Act provision in clause No. 9.

After deliberations, the Authority decides as follows:-

1. To allow the Colleges/Institutes to submit their admission details online for 10 days only for the Academic Year 2017-18, subject to payment of penalty @ 20% on total 'Processing Fees', as approved by the Authority in its meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> December 2017 at Item No. 3. No further extension will be allowed which may be noted by all the Colleges/Institutes.
2. To permit the Colleges/Institutes to submit the proposals for approval of admissions duly certified by concerned Directorates in prescribed format. The concerned Directorate will scrutinize the admission proposals and also check all relevant documents along with Non-creamy Layer Certificate, Caste Validity Certificate, etc.
3. To submit the proposals along with report of Directorates for approval of Authority.
4. The approval to the proposals for approval of admission Proposals received after 31<sup>st</sup> Jan 2018, will be given as per the clarification to be received by the Government of Maharashtra with respect to the amendment to the provisions of section 9(5) of the Act, 2015.
5. In continuation to the above, the Authority decides that the Colleges/Institutes who have failed to submit such details of admissions, online and proposals for approval of admissions, within prescribed time limit, may not be considered for approval of the Authority and admissions of such Colleges/Institutes shall be deemed to be rejected, without further intimation, which may be noted by the concerned College/Institute and the Students/Parents.

The Authority further directs the office to inform the above decision of the Authority to all concerned Directorates, Universities, Colleges/Institutes. The concerned Colleges/Institutes will inform the decision to the students/parents. Office to take necessary action.

**Item No. 4: To peruse the statement of accounts submitted by office of the Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority for the period dated 01/01/2018 to 31/01/2018.**

Mr. P.E. Gaikwad, Member of the Authority, presented the scenario of NRI proposals verification of Academic Year 2013-14 to 2016-17, which are verified/scrutinized with the assistance of the office in which he explained that the documents of 105 proposals out of total 158 proposals are scrutinized and submitted at the first instance for consideration of the Authority.
