## Item No. 4: To discuss and decide on plan for the verification and approval of admission process of various professional courses for the Academic Year 2018-19.

As per the decision taken by the Authority in its meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2018 at Item No. 6, the Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority submitted in brief regarding on-line portal of the Authority. The Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority also stated that it is necessary to develop separate on-line portal of the Authority to follow the provisions of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 and to avoid delay in process of verification of admissions of the admitted students from the concerned Directorate and approval process of the Authority w.r.t. the students admitted in various professional courses from the Academic Year 2018-19 onwards.

After deliberations, the Authority directs the Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority to take necessary actions in this respect and inform the Authority accordingly.

## Item No. 5: To discuss and decide w.r.t. development of ARA Portal along with presentation of M/s. Celest Technologies LLP (Ref.: Minutes of the Meeting dated 29/06/2018).

Due to some technical problems M/s. Celest Technologies LLP could not show their presentation on on-line approval process of ARA portal. After deliberations, the

The Authority perused the aforesaid compliance reports received from Directorate of AYUSH, Mumbai w.r.t. approval of admissions of First Year Degree and Post Graduate B.A.M.S., B.U.M.S. and B.H.M.S. courses for the Academic Year 2016-17 and 2017-18. After deliberations, the Authority decided to approve the aforesaid admissions on the basis of compliance report submitted by Directorate of AYUSH, Mumbai. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 8: To consider and decide on the representation dated 17<sup>th</sup> July 2018 received from students/parents admitted in First Year BHMS course for the Academic Year 2016-17 at Sai Homoeopathic Medical College, Thane through Institute Level along with Hon'ble High Court Order dated 28/06/2018 in Writ Petition No. 5238 of 2018, ref. Minutes of the Meeting dated 22/02/2018 at Item No. 7.

The Authority perused the aforesaid representation received from the students/parents along with Hon'ble High Court order dated 28/06/2018 in Writ Petition No. 5238 of 2018

The Authority went through the decision taken by the Authority in its meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2018 at Item No. 7.

The Authority heard the aforesaid students as well as Dr. Sudhir B. Mhatre, Chairman of the Said Homoeopathic Medical College, Thane.

Dr. Mhatre submitted that after last round of 'Common Admission Process', College/Institute had 07 vacant seats in 85% Quota. Due to no reply from the concerned authorities the College/Institute the had put up the notice, and it received 11 applications for admission against vacant seats. Accordingly the College/Institute filled up the 07 vacant seats and completed the admission process.

It is noticed that aforesaid College/Institute has filled up 07 vacant seats at the Institute level without the prior permission of the Competent Authority or the State CET-CELL for the Academic Year 2016-17, which is not just, fair, appropriate and valid.

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority feels that the mistake was made by the aforesaid College/Institute and rejection of admissions at this stage would not be a fair justice to the aforesaid students. Considering Academic welfare of the students Authority approves these admissions, as one time measure, subject to fulfillment of following terms/conditions,-

- 1. The Institute/College should be imposed the penalty of 02 times of fees fixed by the Fees Regulating Authority for the Academic Year 2016-17 for that college/institute for their illegal, irregular, unjust and biased admissions.
- 2. The Institution shall submit its notarized affidavit to the Authority within 07 days from date of communication as decided above, mentioning there in that the college/institute will not recover the penalty from the students.
- 3. This decision to be considered as one time measure considering broader interest and welfare of the students and not to be considered as precedent.

Office to take necessary steps and inform accordingly.

Item No. 9: To consider and decide on the letter dated 17<sup>th</sup> July 2018 received from Ahmednagar Homoeopathic Medical College, Ahmednagar w.r.t. the decision taken by the Authority in its meeting held on 29/06/2018 (at Item No. 9) regarding admission of Ku. Vinya Ganeshan Iyyer admitted in BHMS course for the Academic Year 2017-18.

The Authority perused the aforesaid letter received from the Ahmednagar Homoeopathic Medical College, Ahmednagar regarding admission of Ku. Vinya Ganeshan Iyyer admitted in First Year BHMS course for the Academic Year 2017-18.

The Authority went through the decision taken by the Authority in its meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2018 at Item No. 9.

It is noticed that Ku. Vinya Ganeshan Iyyer passed HSC examination from out-side Maharashtra. Rules of Government of Maharashtra it is mandatory that the students have passed the SSC and HSC examination from the State of Maharashtra. The aforesaid College/Institute also failed to inform the Directorate of AYUSH, Mumbai and State CET-CELL. This was against the set procedure. It should not happen in future, which the College/Institute must take note.

In view of the above, after deliberations, as a one-time measure and in the interest of the students, the Authority decides to approve the admission of Ku. Vinya Ganeshan Iyyer for the Academic Year 2017-18, subject to payment of penalty 02 times of fees fixed by the Fees Regulating Authority, Mumbai. The Authority further directs that the said permission is granted only for the Academic Year 2016-17 and the Colleges/Institutes should not treat it as a precedent for the years to come.

The amount of penalty shall be paid by these Institutions within four weeks from the date of publication of these minutes on the official website of the Authority. The Authority directs the College/Institute that payment should be paid in the form of Demand Draft / Pay order in favour of "SECRETARY, ADMISSIONS REGULATING AUTHORITY, MUMBAI", payble at Mumbai or through NEFT/RTGS, Office should provide the bank details of Admissions Regulating Authority to the aforesaid College/Institute for NEFT/RTGS.

Item No. 10: To consider and decide on the letter dated 19<sup>th</sup> June 2018 received from Directorate of AYUSH, Mumbai w.r.t. the decision taken by the Authority in its meeting held on 29/06/2018 (at Item No. 11) regarding admission of Ku. The Authority went through the decision taken by the Authority in its meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2018 at Item No. 11.

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority decides to accept the submission dated 19/06/2018 of the Directorate of AYUSH, Mumbai.

After deliberations, the Authority decides not to approve the admission of Ku. Horne Swapnil Sunil admitted at S.V.N. Ayurved College, Rahuri, Ahmednagar for the Academic Year 2017-18. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 11: To consider and decide on the letters dated 4<sup>th</sup> July 2018 received from Ku. Ankita Rajesh Sonawane asking to convert her category to open quota, admitted in First Year BAMS course for the Academic Year 2011-12 and reply thereon dated 14/07/2018 submitted by the Sumatibhai Shah Ayurved College, Pune.

The Authority perused the aforesaid letters received from Ku. Ankita Rajesh Sonawane requesting to convert her category to Open Quota, admitted in First Year BAMS course for the Academic Year 2011-12 and reply thereon submitted by the Sumatibhai Shah Ayurved College, Pune.

The Authority also perused the report submitted by the Directorate AYUSH, Mumbai Vide letter no. DOA/AnkitaSonavane/ST/Change/2018/Ayu-2/12096, dated 23/07/2018.

After deliberation, on the basis of report submitted by the Directorate of AYUSH the Authority decides not to accede to the request of Ku. Ankita Rajesh Sonwane to convert her category to open quota. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 12: To discuss and decide on hearing w.r.t. the decision taken by the Authority in its meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2018 at Item No. 14 regarding admissions of NRI students where the relation between sponsor and candidate is other than first degree blood relative.

The Authority went through the decision taken by the Authority in its meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2018 at Item No. 14.

The Authority also perused the reply submitted by the aforesaid Colleges/Institutes w.r.t. the show cause issued by the Authority to the Colleges/Institutes, regarding relation between candidate and sponsor.

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority feels that the mistake are made by the aforesaid College/Institute. Since rejection of admissions at this stage would not be a fair justice to the aforesaid students. Considering Academic welfare of the student the Authority decides to approve the said admission, as one time measure, subject to fulfillment of following terms/conditions,-

- The Institute/College should be imposed the penalty of 02 times of the fees fixed by the Fees Regulating Authority for admitted Academic Year for their illegal, irregular, unjust and biased admissions.
- 2. The Institution shall submit its notarized affidavit to the Authority within 07 days from date of communication and specifically mention that the said penalty will not be recovered from the students/parents.
- 3. This decision be considered as one time measure considering broader interest and welfare of the students and not to be considered as precedent.

Office to take necessary steps and inform accordingly.

#### Part-II: Higher and Technical Education

Item No. 13: To consider, discuss and decide the proposals of approval of the admissions to Higher & Technical Education courses for the Academic Year 2016-17 and 2017-18, where the there are no discrepancies.

The Admissions Regulating Authority perused observations of the Director, Technical Education, Mumbai/Director Higher Education, Pune,

After deliberations, the Authority decided to approve the aforesaid admissions on the basis of report submitted by Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai and Directorate of Higher Education, Pune for the Academic Year 2016-17 and 2017-18, where there are no discrepancies, the details of which are as marked as **Annexure - C**.

The Authority further decides that this approval is subject to the amendment in the provision of section 9(5) of the Act, 2015, as communicated vide letter no. TEM-2017/C.R.222/TE-4 dated  $8^{th}$  May 2017 by the Government of Maharashtra, Higher and Technical Education Department, Mumbai.

The Authority also made it clear that all the Institutes/Colleges have to pay the "Processing Fees" at the earliest and the approval of the Authority to these proposals since Academic Year 2016-17 is subject to payment of 'Processing Fees'. It will be the responsibility of College/Institute and concerned students to comply the discrepancies. Office to take necessary action.

Item No. 14: To consider and decide on the letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2018 received from Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai regarding transfer of admission of Ku. Akshay Gaikwad admitted in B. Architecture course for the Academic Year 2016-17 along with office letter dated 17/07/2018.

The Authority perused the aforesaid letters received from Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai regarding transfer of admission of Ku. Akshay Gaikwad admitted in B. Architecture course for the Academic Year 2016-17 along with office note dated 17/07/2018.

It is noticed that the Authority in its meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> August 2016 approved the transfer of admission of Ku. Akshay Gaiwad from Idea Architecture College, Wada to Aditya Architecture College, Borivali, Mumbai, subject to submission of marksheet of previous Academic year on or before 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2016, but the Aditya College of Architecture, Borivali, Mumbai failed to submit the marksheet of Ku. Akshay Gaikwad.

Without final approval of Authority for transfer of candidate the parent college relieved the student and admitting college the student to join for the Academic Year 2016-17.

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority feels that rejection of admissions at this stage would not be a fair justice to the student. Considering Academic welfare of the student the Authority decides to approve the said admission, as one time measure, subject to fulfillment of following terms/conditions,-

- The both Institutes/Colleges should be imposed the penalty equal to the fee fixed by the Fees Regulating Authority for the Academic Year 2016-17 for its illegal, irregular, unjust and biased actions.
- 2. The Institution shall submit its notarized affidavit to the Authority within 07 days from date of communication as decided above and specifically mention there in that the said penalty will not be recovered from the student/parents.
- 3. This decision be considered as one time measure considering broader interest and welfare of the student and not to be considered as precedent.

Office to take necessary steps and inform accordingly.

Item No. 15: To consider and decide on the letter dated 4<sup>th</sup> July 2018 received from the Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai regarding transfer of Ku. Sakshi Sahebrao Tupe for Academic Year 2018-19.

The Authority perused the aforesaid letter received from Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai regarding transfer of Ku. Sakshi Sahebrao Tupe for the Academic Year 2018-19.

The Authority also perused the representations submitted by the aforesaid students/parents.

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority decides to empower the Director, Technical Education, Mumbai to take necessary actions w.r.t. transfer of admission of Ku. Sakshi Sahebrao Tupe for the Academic Year 2018-19. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 16: To consider and decide on the letter dated 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2018 received from Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai regarding request of Ku. Srushti Kishor Rithe w.r.t. 'Not Freeze' seat allocation process for the Academic Year 2018-19.

The Authority perused the aforesaid letter received from Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai. Noted.

Item No. 17: To consider and decide on the letter dated 6<sup>th</sup> July 2018 received from Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai regarding transfer in Second Year B. Architecture course of Ku. Vedvrat Kelkar for the Academic Year 2017-18.

The Authority perused the aforesaid letter received from Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai regarding transfer in Second Year B. Architecture course of Ku. Vedvrat Kelkar for the Academic Year 2017-18.

It is noticed that Dr. Baliram Hire College of Architecture, Mumbai and Kavi Kulguru Kalidas Institute, Nagpur both have not followed the proper procedure w.r.t. the transfer of Ku. Vedvrat Kelkar for the Academic Year 2017-18 and without final approval of Authority. The parent college relieved the student and admitting college allowed the student to join for the Academic Year 2017-18.

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority feels that because of mistake of aforesaid both Colleges/Institutes, rejection of admissions at this stage would not be a fair justice to the aforesaid students. Considering Academic welfare of the student the Authority approved the said admission, as one time measure, subject to fulfillment of following terms/conditions,-

- 1. The both Institutes/Colleges should be imposed the penalty equal to the fee fixed by the Fees Regulating Authority for the Academic Year 2017-18 for their illegal, irregular, unjust and biased admissions.
- 2. The Institution shall submit its notarized affidavit to the Authority within 07 days from date of communication as decided above and specifically mention therein that the said penalty will not be recovered from the students/parents.
- 3. This decision be considered as one time measure considering broader interest and welfare of the students and not to be considered as precedent.

Office to take necessary steps and inform accordingly.

Item No. 18: To consider and decide on the letter dated 12<sup>th</sup> July 2018 received from Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai regarding confirmation of admissions of students admitted in Maulana Azad Educational Trust, Millennium Institute of Management, Aurangabad through CAP for MBA course for the Academic Year 2018-19.

The Authority perused the aforesaid letter received from Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai confirmation of admissions of students admitted in Maulana Azad Educational Trust, Millennium Institute of Management, Aurangabad through CAP for MBA course for the Academic Year 2018-19.

It is submitted that All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi (AICTE) has given extension of approval and accordingly Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad has given affiliation to Maulana Azad Educational Trust, Millennium Institute of Management, Aurangabad, but aforesaid College/Institute requested for 'Closure of course/Institute' and vide letter dated 16/05/2018 of employees of the said College/Institute requested to the Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai not to consider the request of the College/Institute for 'Closer of Course/Institute'. The Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai incorporated the Maulana Azad Educational Trust, Millennium Institute of Management, Aurangabad in 'Common Admission Process' for admission of the students for the Academic Year 2018-19.
