Authority noted and approved the action of the office.

In view of the provisions of section 9 sub section 3 of Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Education Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 (Mah. Act No. XXVIII of 2015) published on 17th August 2015, the Pravesh Niyantran Samiti existing as on the date of commencement of the Act shall continue to exercise the powers of Admissions Regulating Authority till such authority is duly constituted under the Act.

Item No. 3: To consider and decide the procedure for finalization of Bidder for Computer based online examination for Academic Year 2016-17 from e-Tender No. 2.

Authority in its meeting dated 18/12/2015 directed to State CET-CELL to examine the technical and financial capacity of the bidder quoting the same rates for e-Tender No. 2. Accordingly the Technical Committee submitted the comparative chart showing the number of students, the number of students in single slot, turn over and profit of the bidder through online computer based examinations. Authority also perused the chart produced by the State CET-CELL.

Commissioner, State CET-CELL stated that as per the purchase procedure and CVC guidelines negotiation or any alterations can not be done once the commercial e-envelop is opened. So the only option remains with the CET CELL is to get the fresh rates from the bidders quoting same rates earlier. Accordingly, office of the Commissioner, State CET-CELL informed to bidders and they are asked to submit their rates in sealed envelop to the office of the Commissioner, State CET-CELL. After receiving the same it will be placed before the Authority for its consideration. Also, this whole process shall be got vetted by I.T. Department of Government of Maharashtra and if needed, approval of High Power Committee (HPC) shall be asked for.

Item No. 4: To discuss and decide on an appointment of the Agency to conduct online CETs to be held before 1st May 2016.

Authority perused the letter dated 19/01/2016 received from the Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai recommending the agency to conduct online computer based examinations for MBA/MMS-CET (12 & 13 March 2016) and MCA-CET (26 & 27 March 2016) by Indian Banking Personnel Service (IBPS).

Dr. S.K. Mahajan, Director, Technical Education, Mumbai pointed out that Academic Year 2014-15 three exams were conducted online in viz. - 1) MBA/MMS-CET, 2) MCA-CET and 3) B.HMCT-CET through M/s. IBPS. In Academic Year 2015-16 DTE conducted these exams, online, through M/s. Manipal Technologic Ltd. but DTE faced lots of technical difficulties with M/s. Manipal Technologic, Ltd. and M/s. Manipal Technologic, Ltd. also denied to conduct the said CET for the current Academic Year 2016-17. M/s IBPS is ready to conduct all these three CETs this year through online in same rates quoted earlier.

Dr. Dhanraj Mane, Director, Higher Education, Pune also requested to the Authority to conduct 1) LLB-CET (3 year course) and 2) LLB-CET (5 year course) through online.

In view of the above, after deliberations, Authority directs to the CET-CELL that all CETs here in after to be conducted as per the last year manner.

The Authority permits to conduct online CETs for 1) MBA/MMS and 2) MCA and 3) B.HMCT courses through M/s. IBPS with the same rates as recommended by the Director, Technical Education, Mumbai. Office of the Commissioner of State CET-CELL to take necessary steps. Authority further directs to the Directorate of Higher Education, Pune to submit their proposals for conducting online CET for 1) LLB-CET (3 Year course) and 2) LLB-CET (5 Year course). Rates though remain same as last year, work scope shall include that of MKCL last year, as MKCL is no longer being given that scope. Office to take necessary steps.

Item No. 5: To discuss and decide in respect of the separate account of the Authorities and State CET-CELL.

Authority perused the proposals submitted by the office of the Commissioner, State CET-CELL in respect of separate Accounts of the Authorities and State CET-CELL.

As mentioned in section 16 (1) and (4) of the Act, the concerned Authorities shall open separate Bank accounts in the Nationalized Bank and meet their expenses from the receipts.

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Accordingly, the Commissioner, State CET-CELL proposed to open a new bank account in the name of "Admissions Regulating Authority" and to decide the authorized signatory to operate the account. At present there is a separate bank account in Bank of Maharashtra, Bandra (E) branch in the name of "Office Secretary, Shikshan Shulka Samiti and Pravesh Niyantran Samiti, Mumbai". It is therefore requested to recommend to the Government to transfer fifty percent of the net balance amount in the account of "Admissions Regulating Authority"., remaining 50% may be deposited in the account of Fees Regulating Authority if, Government so desires and to close the existing account of the Samiti.

The Commissioner also further placed on record that the new account has been opened in State Bank India, institutional banking division, Fort, Mumbai in the name of "Commissioner, State CET-CELL, Maharashtra State, Mumbai" to receive the amount collected towards the application fees from the candidates applying for various CETs conducted by State CET-CELL.

The Commissioner pointed out that till date i) Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai, ii) Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai, iii) Directorate of Higher Education, Pune and iv) Directorate of AYUSH, Mumbai have separate CET-PLA accounts for incurring income and expenditure related to CET examinations and therefore requested to the Authority to recommend to the Government of Maharashtra to transfer the balance amount of the said accounts maintained by different Directorates to the Commissioner, State CET-CELL bank account.

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority directs the Commissioner to appoint the responsible Authorized Signatory for newly accounts to be opened in the name of "Admissions Regulating Authority" and inform the Authority accordingly. The Authority further also decided to recommend to the Government of Maharashtra 1) to transfer 50% of amount to account of Admissions Regulating Authority and close account of Samiti, 2) to transfer the balance amount in the CET-PLA accounts maintained by various Directors to the Commissioner, State CET-CELL account.

Item No. 6: To discuss and decide in respect of the Office space for Authorities and State CET-CELL as per requirement.

Office of the Commissioner pointed out that the sufficient space for office is not available.

After deliberations, the Authority authorized the Commissioner, State CET-CELL, Mumbai for making available the office space for Authorities and State CET-CELL as per requirement and submit the report before the Authority for its consideration.

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Item No. 7: To discuss and decide the remuneration to be given to the personnel involved in various CETs.

The Authority perused the chart submitted by the office of the Commissioner, State CET-CELL in respect of remuneration to various staff/personnel involved in various CET examinations, after deliberations, Authority approved the same.
