i) As shown in column no. 5 above, out of total 1008 Institutes, 92 institutes of Health Science courses and 916 institutes of Higher and Technical Courses have so far not submitted their admissions details online, for the Academic Year 2016-17.

It is pointed out that various colleges submitted their request to open online link.

After deliberations, the Authority decides to extend and allow them to submit their admissions details online from 7th March 2017 to 14th March 2017 for the Academic Year 2016-17.

ii) As shown in column no. 8, above, total 1505 (33 Health Science + 1472 Higher and Technical Courses) the proposals are under scrutiny.

In view of it, the Authority directs the office to verify and put up proposals in the coming meetings for its consideration in due course.

iii) It is observed that total 2216 (375 for Health Science courses + 1841 for Higher and Technical Courses) Colleges/Institutes, as shown in column no. 9 above, have not submitted the proposals for approval of admissions for the Academic Year 2016-17.

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Attention of the Authority is also drawn to the Chapter III, Section 9, subsection (5), clause (iii) of the Government of Maharashtra Act No. XXVIII of 2015.

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority decides to suggest the Higher and Technical Education Department, Government of Maharashtra to take the necessary steps at the earliest and inform the Authority accordingly.

A) Medical Education :-

Item No. 4: To consider and decide on the Verification/ Observation report dated 19th December, 2016 and 13th February, 2017 received from the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai for Academic Year 2015-16.

The Admissions Regulating Authority perused the observation reports dated 19/12/2016 and 13/02/2017 w.r.t. B.Sc. Nursing (04 Colleges) and B.P.Th. (01 College) submitted by the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai for Academic Year 2015-16. The report of Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai is marked herewith as **Annexure-A**.

It is seen that the Directorate in its verification reports has mentioned that three B.Sc. Nursing Colleges/Institutes, admitted students from both the lists i.e. MH-CET-2015, Asso-CET-2015 and also admitted Non-CET students during the admission process. The Authority perused the Government Resolution No. एमईडी १०१५/प्र.क्र. ७६/१५/शिक्षण - २, dated 29th April 2015, in this regard.

The Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority pointed out some discrepancies in the observation e.g. no. of admitted students does not match with the sanctioned intake capacity of the Institute/College, no. of students admitted from respective CETs, (i.e. MHCET or ASSO-CET) also does not match with intake capacity and CET Marks of all students are not mentioned etc. DMER should submit the detailed report of each Institute/College, candidate wise, indicating category, CET, Discrepancy. Accordingly the submitted report needs to be rectified by the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai.

The Admissions Regulating Authority, after deliberations decides to approve the collegewise admissions for Academic Year 2015-16, where the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai found no discrepancy. Further it is decided that the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai should rectify the discrepancies with appropriate compliances and submit the correct report within two weeks.

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Item No. 5: To consider and decide on the explanation dated 15th February, 2017 submitted by Yogita Dental College and Hospital, Khed, Ratnagiri in respect of decision taken in the Minutes of Meeting held on 18th January, 2017 at Item no. 9, for Academic Year 2015-16 PG Dental course.

The Authority perused the letter under reference received from the Yogita Dental College and Hospital, Khed, Ratnagiri in respect of decision taken in the Minutes of meeting held on 18th January 2017 at Item No. 9 regarding allocation of seats under CAP and Management/NRI Quota for Post Graduate Dental course for the Academic Year 2015-16.

The Authority observes that the aforesaid College has opted for the admission process conducted by the Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra on the basis of results of APGD-CET-2015 for admissions to Post Graduate MDS course for the Academic Year 2015-16.

The Authority also perused the verification/observation report submitted by the Directorate of Medical and Research, Mumbai and the decision taken in the minutes of meeting held on 18th January, 2017 at Item No. 9 regarding the ratio of the admissions done in CAP and Management/NRI Quota. In Management/NRI Quota, College/Institute admitted the students more than 50% seats i.e. 7 out of 11 for the Academic Year 2015-16 without the prior permission of the Admissions Regulating Authority, which is against the set procedure. It is serious in nature and the same should not happen in future, which may be noted by the college.

In view of the above, after deliberations, as a one time measure and in the interest of the student, the Authority decides to approve the admission process of Yogita Dental College and Hospital, Khed, Ratnagiri for Post Graduate Dental courses for the Academic Year 2015-16, **subject to payment of penalty of Rs. 5,00,000/-** and compliance of eligibility Rules laid down by respective Authorities. The Authority further directs that the said permission is granted only for the Academic Year 2015-16 and the College/Institute should not treat it as a precedent for the years to come.

The amount of penalty shall be paid by the Institution within a period of two weeks from the date of publication of these minutes on the official website of the Authority. The Authority directs the College/Institute that payment should be paid in the form of Demand Draft / Pay order in favour of "THE SECRETARY, ADMISSIONS REGULATING AUTHORITY, MUMBAI", payable at Mumbai.

The Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik may also be requested to give eligibility and enrollment to the student for the Academic Year 2015-16, subject to fulfillment of the above conditions by the aforesaid College/Institute. Office to take necessary steps.

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Item No. 6: **To consider and decide on letter dated 6th February, 2017 received from MIMER Medical College, Talegaon Dabhade, Pune explaining in respect of complain of Rahul Yuvraj Ahire regarding Irregularity of Admission Process in the College, for the course of MBBS and BDS in the Academic Year 2016-17. [Ref. Minutes of the Meeting held on 21st December, 2016 Agenda Item No. 6 (a)].**

The Authority perused the letters under reference received from M.I.M.E.R. Medical College, Talegaon Dabhade, Pune in respect of complaint of Ku. Rahul Yuvraj Ahire regarding irregularity of Admission Process of the college for the MBBS and BDS course for the Academic Year 2016-17.

The Authority also went through the decisions taken by the Authority in its meeting held on 21st December, 2016 at Item No. 6(a). As per the decision taken in its meeting dated 21st December 2016 at Item No. 6(a), the explanation is submitted by the College/Institute, however the remarks of the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai have not been received by the Authority office.

It is pointed out that admission process of the aforesaid College/Institute was completed under the control and observation of the Commissioner, State CET-CELL and Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai through "Special Counseling". The Commissioner had appointed Dr. M.P. Bankar, Professor, Department of Biochemistry, B.J. Medical College and Sassun General Hospital, Pune as Observer to observe, verify and scrutinize the admission process of the aforesaid College/Institute.

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority decides to forward the explanation dated 06/02/2017 submitted by the M.I.M.E.R. Medical College, Pune and complaint dated 29/11/2016 of Ku. Rahul Yuvraj Ahire to Dr. M.P. Bankar for his report on it. It is also directed that Dr. M.P. Bankar should submit it immediately to the Director, Directorate of Medical Education and the Director should submit his report thereon with remarks to the Authority office within two weeks to the Authority. After receipt of the same it will be placed before the Authority for its consideration. Office to take necessary steps.

Item No. 7: **To consider letter dated 7th February, 2017 received from N.K.P. Salve Institute of Medical Sciences and Lata Mangeshkar Hospital requesting for personal hearing with respect to approval of admissions of PG students on the basis of PGM CET and AIPGMAA for the Academic Year 2014-15. [Ref. Minutes of Meeting held on 18th January, 2017 at Item no. 6(b)].**

The Authority perused the letter under reference received from N.K.P. Salve Institute of Medical Sciences and Lata Mangeshkar Hospital, Nagpur requesting for personal hearing with respect to approval of admissions of PG students on the basis of PGM-CET and AIPGMAA in Academic Year 2014-15.

The Authority went through the decision taken by the Authority in its meeting held on 18th January 2017.

It is also noticed that the aforesaid college/institute submitted its say in respect of Minutes of Meeting held on 18th January, 2017 at Item no. 6(b) vide its letter dated 27th February, 2017.

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority decides that the say dated 27/02/2017 submitted by College should be scrutinized and verified by the Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority and submit his report before the Authority in the next meeting for its consideration. Office to take necessary steps and inform the concerned college accordingly.

Item No. 8: **To decide on proposals w.r.t. admissions in 15% NRI Quota for the Academic Year 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17.**

Item No. 8(a): **To consider and decides on proposals where there are no discrepancies.**

The Authority perused the Verification Report submitted by the office of the Authority on the status of the NRI candidates who were admitted to Under Graduate Course in Academic Year 2012-13 and to Post Graduate Course in Academic Year 2014-15.

In consideration of the above, the Authority decides to approve the admissions of following NRI candidates who were admitted in Under Graduate Course and Post Graduate Course for the Academic Year 2012-13 and 2014-15, respectively.

Item No. 8(b): To consider and discuss on proposals where there are discrepancies.

The Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority stated that the requisite documents as per the Authority office letter dated 18-04-2016 to prove the relationship between sponsor & the student and to prove the NRI status of the sponsor have found to be not submitted, complete in all respect. In this regard the individual Colleges/Institutes have also been informed from time to time about the discrepancies by separate letters to submit the requisite documents at the earliest to the Authority office.

The Secretary pointed out that the Colleges/Institutes submitted documents which are not as per the guidelines already issued. Hence, claims of the students for approval of admission in 15% NRI Quota admitted to Under Graduate Courses and Post Graduate Courses in Academic Year 2012-13 and 2014-15, respectively may be disapproved, the details of which are listed as follows:-
